

# Sayre Projects

## A Great Opportunity!

Past Grand President and Hall of Famer Bill Sayre has generously provided the funding for **Sayre Projects** through the Educational Foundation of Alpha Gamma Rho.

Sayre Projects are new or enhanced **Foundation**-sponsored retreats, conferences, seminars and similar opportunities. The projects are for both alumni and undergraduates, along with associated university faculty members, where they communicate and cooperate to further develop their leadership skills for the benefit of a broader and better agriculture.

The first **Sayre Projects** were announced in Fall 1998. An Allocation Committee was appointed by the President of the Foundation to administer the projects. The Allocation Committee makes final decisions with respect to each **Sayre Project** .

The Allocation Committee will invite **Sayre Project** proposals from as wide as possible a group of AGR leaders and staff and shall favor projects which involve more than one chapter of Alpha Gamma Rho. The project should have as its goal to strengthen and develop leadership skills and management understanding of both undergraduates and alumni and encourage their working together.
